Parade Route:

The parade starts at Kaala Elementary School located at 130 California Avenue, will travel up California Avenue, cross Kamehameha Highway, turn left on North Cane Street, then left on Center Street, going as far as you can before stopping. This is approximately 12 blocks. The route is covered by insurance and monitored by police, so please DO NOT deviate from this route. The best pickup area after the parade will be on Center Street.

Starting time and place:

PLEASE SEND ONE REPRESENTATIVE TO CHECK IN AT THE BUS STOP IN FRONT OF KAALA SCHOOL to confirm your presence and your spot in the line-up. The assembly of participants will begin at 8:00 AM. We want to have everyone in position to start promptly at 9:00 AM.

Drivers:

Please proceed slowly and watch for spectators, especially little children. If you have a float, please have someone assigned to help if the driver's vision is hampered.

Spacing:

Your group should be 10 yards behind the group in front. Spectators should be able to enjoy the unit as it approaches, watch it go by, then have enough time to look for the next unit.
